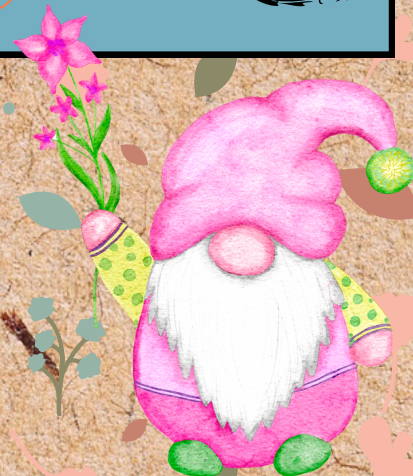

Nutrition and Literacy Month

No Bake Breakfast Cookies

These no-bake cookies can be customized to include any extra toppings of your choice!

Serves: 16 | Prep Time: 5 mins | Total Time: 15 mins + 1hr chilling time

Ingredients

1 1/2 cups peanut butter
2 tsp honey or maple syrup
2 tsp vanilla extract
4 tsp chia seeds
1 1/2 cups oat

Extra

Chopped almonds, Raisins, Pumpkin seeds

Place the peanut butter, honey and vanilla in a bowl.
Stir the mixture until well combined, then add in the remaining ingredients.
Stir well and ensure everything is well incorporated.
Roll the mixture into 16 balls and place the balls on a baking tray lined with parchment paper.
Press the balls flat slightly and place them in the fridge for at least an hour.
